

What is Cursillo?

An often life changing weekend designed to raise up the lay leadership of the church and give them tools to share the Good News with those in their environments at home, work and in the community.



Is this for couples only?

This is open to any Episcopalian, ELCA Lutheran or Catholic adult – married or single. It is a valuable experience for couples to share, and equally valuable for singles. Married couples will share a room; singles will be in a room with other singles.



Where is it held?

Two weekends a year, Thursday evening through Sunday afternoon, are held at Camp Capers in Waring, Texas; two weekends are held at Mustang Island Conference Center on Mustang Island at Port Aransas.



How much is it?
