2011 World Mission Annual Report

Mission & Purpose. The World Mission Department seeks to engage every member and every church of the diocese in the work of evangelism and mission. We are working to be faithful to the Great Commission, Jesus Christ's command to "go therefore and make disciples of all the nations" (Matthew 28:19) and his Great Commandment "to love your neighbor as yourself." (Matthew 22:39)

Ministries. In 2011 the World Mission Department of the Diocese of West Texas sent **388** participants on **58** short-term mission teams to **Belarus, China, Guatemala, Haiti, Honduras, Kenya, Madagascar, Mexico, Peru, Puerto Rico, Russia, Rwanda, Sudan, Tanzania, Uganda, and Viet Nam.**

Our ministries in these foreign countries included:

Spreading the Gospel through word and deed.

Digging water wells and teaching hygiene.

Providing medical and dental treatments.

Providing veterinary treatment and supplies.

Providing transportation.

Providing scholarships, school supplies, computers.

Sponsoring Christian children's literature in the former Soviet Union.

Sponsor for Isle of Hope Day Care for Handicapped, Belarus.

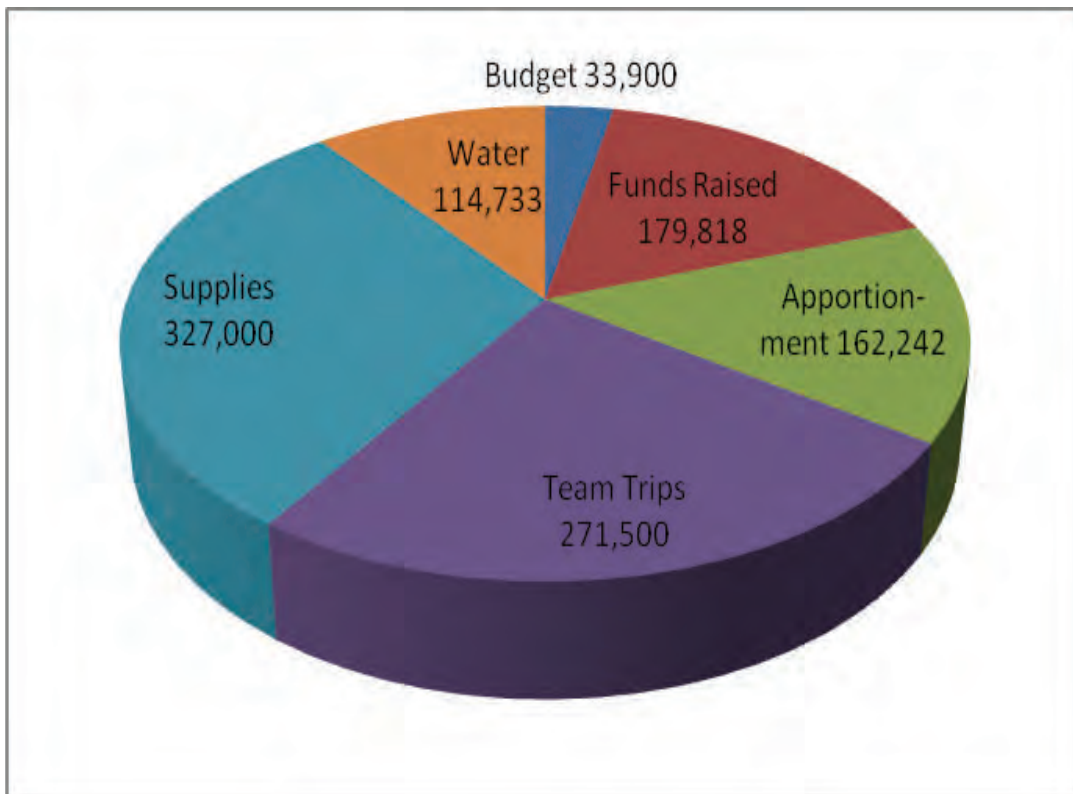
New sound system for St. Peter's Cathedral, in Hoima, Uganda.

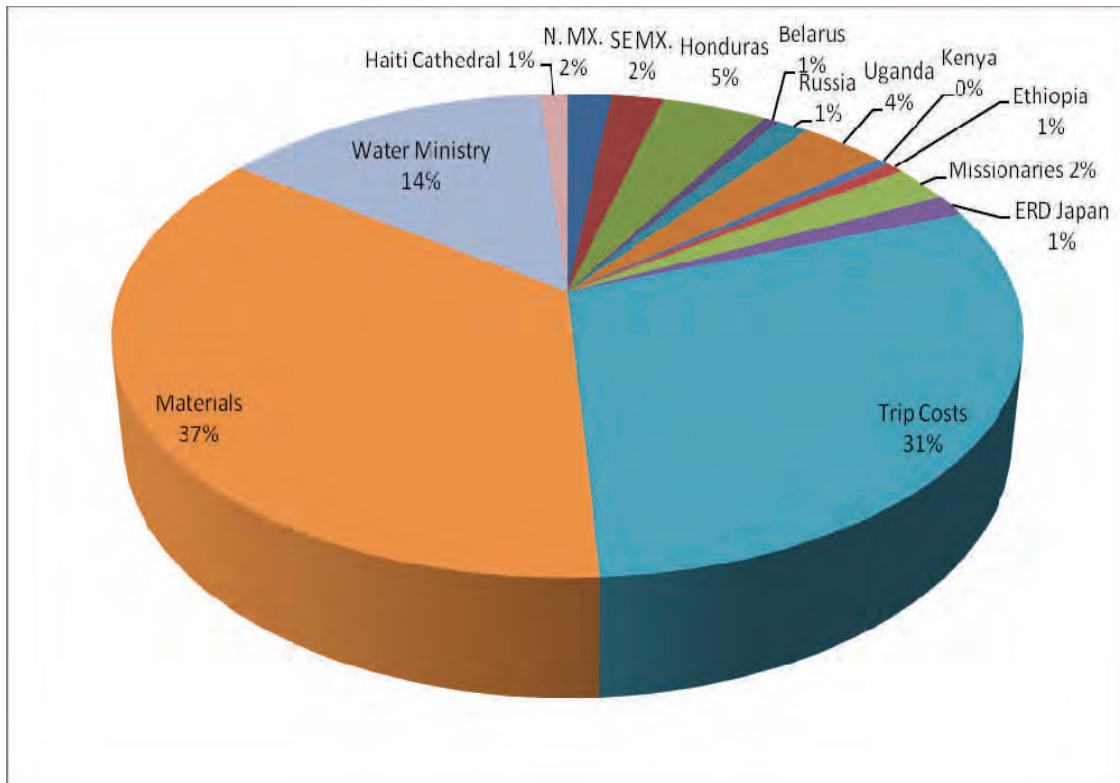
